Entry Requirements

Malaysians

- Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) or its equivalent with a minimum of ONE (1) credit and pass in the following subjects:
- (a) Bahasa Melayu / Bahasa Malaysia
 - (b) Science Subjects:
 - i. Biology or Chemistry or Physics, OR
 - ii. Science/General Science/Applied Science
 - (c) History

Non - Malaysians

- GCE O-Level or equivalent with ONE (1) and pass in the following Science subjects :
- i. Biology or Chemistry or Physics, OR
 - ii. Science/General Science/Applied Science

Unified Examinations Certificate (UEC) with minimum Grade B in one subject and pass in Science

Candidates who possess certificates in health-related fields recognized and approved by the Malaysian Nursing Board are also welcome to apply. Candidates with other relevant qualifications are subject to approval by the Malaysian Nursing Board

Special Note :

All graduates will be required to sit for the Nursing Assistant registry Examination, offered by the Nursing Board to be awarded with the Annual Practice Certificate (APC)
